Chimineas Permitted within Village of Emo

"Chimineas" with proper covers are permitted within the Village of Emo, providing they meet the following conditions:

- must be located 15 feet away from sideyard, any structure or combustible product and used only during favourable weather conditions
- must have a spark arrester, as per the Ontario Building Code
- only permitted to burn properly seasoned wood products
- must be placed on a non-combustible base
- must be supervised at all times during use
- no burning during burning bans or winds more than 10km/hour

NO OPEN BURNING within the Village of Emo, however no fire permit required for chimineas

FOREST FIRE SAFETY

- Review and discuss safety tips with your entire household to make sure everyone understands what to do in a forest/wildland fire.
- Clearly mark all driveway entrances and display your address so that fire vehicles can easily find your home.
- Practice evacuating your home. Teach all household members the technique of "*stop, drop and roll*" in case clothes catch on fire.
- Install smoke detectors and sprinklers on every floor and by all sleeping areas.
- Plan several escape routes away from your home by car and by foot.
- Create a safety zone around your home. Modify or eliminate brush, trees and other vegetation near your home.

Consult with your local fire department about making your home fire-resistant.

Restriction to Water Use

Residents may water lawns, flowers, etc. on the following days:

South of Railroad Tracks
on **Even Calendar Days**

North of Railroad Tracks
on **Odd Calendar Days**

Hours for non-essential water usage:

**5:00 a.m. – 7:00 a.m. and
8:00 p.m. – 10:00 p.m.**

Effective May 15 to September 15
Your cooperation is essential in water usage.

The Water Usage By-law includes a penalty clause in the amount of **\$300.00** for those persons who ignore to follow the set schedule for using watering for non-essential purposes.
