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## Procedures for Entering/Exiting the Arena and Ice Surface

### **ICE RENTALS DURING EVEN HOURS**

- Participants entering the arena for ice rentals during even hours (4:00, 6:00, 8:00, 10:00, etc.) will enter the arena through the main door and proceed to dressing room 1 (connected to dressing room 4). Upon entry to the arena, players and/or person attending with the player, will not be permitted to leave and re-enter. Once you leave the arena, you will not be permitted re-entry.
- The first participants to arrive will proceed through dressing room 1 to dressing room 4 until that dressing room is full, before using dressing room 1.
- There are three over flow chairs outside of dressing room 4 to be used if the rental group has more than 18 skaters. If this is the case, these spots must be filled first before following the procedure of filling dressing room 4 and 1.
- If a parent or guardian enters the dressing room with their child, they must stay with that child (in a “bubble”) until it is time to proceed to the ice surface. Once in the dressing room, the person attending with the player, will not be permitted to leave until the child leaves with the team.
- When it is time to proceed to the ice surface, players and their parents will leave from room 4 first, and file out through the door by the canteen to the ice surface. Participants will go on the ice, and parents/guardians will proceed to the stands. There will be no spectators allowed inside the lobby.
- When ice time ends, parents/guardians will enter through room 4 and go through to room 1 to assist in removing skates and helmets. Participants will put on boots and jackets and leave the arena through the main doors.
- All parents and player will be required to check in and out with the team representative responsible for filling out the COVID-19 tracking forms.

### **ICE RENTALS DURING ODD HOURS**

- Participants entering the arena for ice rentals during odd hours (5:00, 7:00, 9:00 etc.) will enter the arena through the east door by the office and proceed to dressing room 2 (connected to dressing room 3). Upon entry to the arena, players and/or person attending with the player, will not be permitted to leave and re-enter. Once you leave the arena, you will not be permitted re-entry.
- The first participants to arrive will proceed through dressing room 2 to dressing room 3 until that dressing room is full, before using dressing room 2.
- There are three over flow chairs outside of dressing room 2 (along the lockers) to be used if the rental group has more than 18 skaters. These spots can be used after both dressing rooms are full.
- If a parent or guardian enters the dressing room with their child, they must stay with that child (in a “bubble”) until it is time to proceed to the ice surface. Once in the dressing room, the person attending with the player, will not be permitted to leave until the child leaves with the team.
- When it is time to proceed to the ice surface, players and their parents will leave from room 1 and file out through the door by the office to the ice surface. Participants will go on the ice, and parents/guardians will proceed to the stands. There will be no spectators allowed inside the lobby.
- When ice time ends, parents/guardians will enter room 2 and proceed through to room 3 to assist in removing skates and helmets. Participants will put on boots and jackets and leave the arena through the door by the office.
- All parents and player will be required to check in and out with the team representative responsible for filling out the COVID-19 tracking forms.
